AI-Based AP Automation and Line-Level Matching

Rapid implementations that automate both AP invoice creation and receiver matching with almost zero setup.

The AI-based template-less solution simplifies and minimizes the implementation time required to just hours/days, thus keeping the Total Cost of Ownership low and maximizing the Return on Investment. This is achieved because no template definitions are required, thus minimizing internal friction and the effort, time, and cost to go live.

The new automated invoice/receiver line-level matching process leverages the line-level information created by the automated extraction processes. For most companies, this represents a dramatic reduction in both cost and effort when compared with existing deferred vouchering and manual vouchering processes.

Real-Time Electronic Reviews and Approvals/Rejections via Email or Teams Chat Without Logging into C1



Learn how the new approval processes offer PR, PO, and AP approval solutions, where the out-of-the-box solution provides:

- Standard authentication and connectivity to synchronize necessary approval information between C1 v2 and M365.
- Flexible sample approval workflows that can be extended/built to meet the specific business need using either Power Automate or AI tools.
- An electronic review and approve/reject process conducted outside of C1, where:
- Approval/rejection is conducted via email/Teams Chat without logging into C1.
- Instant access to relevant documents/content (i.e., electronic copies of PR, PO, supplier invoices, pack slips, damage reports, etc. in SharePoint) is provided via the email/Chat (again without logging into C1).
